Information with regards to the publication of the new MIS 3005 standard on 6th September 2011

NOTE. The implementation date for MIS 3005 v3.0 was extended from 6th December 2011 to allow additional training to take place and development of a guidance document to support the new standard. The revised implementation timeline is shown below.

Following the publication of the new MIS 3005 v3.0 on 6th September 2011 with regards to the implementation and date of withdrawal of the old MIS Standard, please see the details below.

Publication Date: 6th September 2011

Implementation Timescale :

All new quotes / orders must be compliant with MIS 3005 v3.0	From 1st February 2012
Existing quotes where no order received and not yet installed, i.e. no contract has been signed	On expiry of existing quote to be treated as new quote. Period of quote validity to be determined by installation company's standard quote validity policy, e.g. 1, 2, or 3 months etc.
Existing orders yet to install and installations in progress, i.e. a contract has been signed	No deadline / requirement to comply with MIS 3005 v3.0

All installation companies can work to version 3.0 of the Standard from the date of publication (6th September 2011).

All new quotes must be compliant with MIS 3005 from 1st February 2012. Existing quotes where no order has been received and the system is not yet installed will be valid for the remainder of the quote validity period. On expiry of the quote the job should be treated as a new quote. Existing orders yet to install have no set deadline / requirement to comply with MIS 3005 v3.0.

Installation companies joining the Scheme with their assessments after the implementation date for new quotes (1st February 2012) must work to version 3.0 of the Standard.

Installation companies having an annual surveillance visit after the implementation date (1st February 2012) must be working to the new version 3.0 of the Standard.

Installation companies having their annual surveillance visit before the implementation date (1st February 2012) will be assessed against version 2.0 of the Standard.
